NORTHERN INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK EXPOSITION

WHO WE ARE

The Northern International Livestock Exposition (NILE) is one of the largest agricultural events in the Northwest.

A focus of the show has always been participation of youth in a variety of events. Through participation you will build communication skills, friendships and experience that will aid in your future endeavors. Ten (10) scholarships are given annually to qualifying 4-H and FFA members who have participated in NILE events and wish to continue their education beyond high school.



4-H AND FFA COMPETITIONS

LIVESTOCK EVALUATION

Each year over 400 4-H and FFA students from across the United States and Canada gather to compete in one of the largest livestock evaluation contest in the United States. The contest typically includes classes of breeding and market animals for cattle, sheep and hogs as well as oral reasons.

Livestock and officials are provided by Northwest College, Powell, Wyoming, with assistance from nearby Montana State University, Bozeman.

HORSE EVALUATION

Rocky Mountain College in Billings, MT provides the horses, judges and handlers for the NILE Horse Evaluation Contest. The contest involves classes of halter and performance horses and oral reasons.

SALES AND SERVICE

This contest, open to FFA teams only, provides competition designed to showcase participant's sales, communication and teamwork skills. Contest is limited to the first 30 teams registered.



STOCK SHOWS

JR. FED SHOW AND SALE OF CHAMPIONS

Available to only 4-H and FFA members, this show includes divisions for Market Steers, Market Lambs and Market Hogs. The top end of each species will be auctioned off during the Jr. Fed Sale of Champions.

CLUB CALF SHOW AND SALE

This event features some of the premier club calves in the Northwest. All calves are evaluated through the show ring and then offered in the annual NILE Club Calf Sale. Calves sold through this sale have gone on to win numerous jackpot shows and county and state fairs throughout the country.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

MERIT HEIFER

Each year, 25 teens ages 13-17, are selected to receive a breeding heifer through our live animal scholarship program. The goal of the program is to help young producers begin their own cattle herd. The heifers are donated from cattle producers from across the region. Recipients are chosen based on merit, goals and ability.

Each participant is responsible for raising their heifer and showing her as a bred heifer at the NILE Stock Show. At project completion, recipients will receive full title to their heifer and her offspring.
