If a class has ten (10) or more animals entered, then there may be consideration of the class to be divided into two (2) equal classes with natural age breaks. This show is subject to the Northern International Livestock Expo General Rules and Regulations, and to the Special Rules of this section. Where Special Rules conflict with other rules, Special Rules prevail.

- Entries must be registered with the American Hereford Association. Animals with 'pending' or 'applied for' registration are not eligible to show.
- Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the MHBA Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the show committee representing the MHBA.
- All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- All entries will be measured. Maximum height to be shown in these classes is 45 inches on mature females and 48 inches on mature bulls and steers.
- Any animal exceeding the height limit will not be eligible to show.
- All horned and polled Miniature Hereford cattle will show together.
- Any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible to show.
- The 2023 NILE Show has been accepted as a MHBA AIME Points Show. MHBA AIME Points Show Rules and eligibility can be found on the MHBA website.

Steer Class Numbers:

Miniature Hereford Youth Classes Class Numbers:

MHBA Youth classes are open to all MHBA members ages 3-22.

Exhibitor's age 3 to 8 must be accompanied by an assistant showman (See MHBA Show Rules for show ring assistant requirements for pre-junior ages 3-8). All animals entered must have shown individually in the Miniature Hereford Show. Questions may be directed to the show superintendent.

22. Junior Prospect Heifer - Calved 1/1/2023 or later**

23. Junior Prospect Steer: **Must not** exceed 12 months of age on day of show.

24. Junior Showmanship - class may be split into four age divisions**
