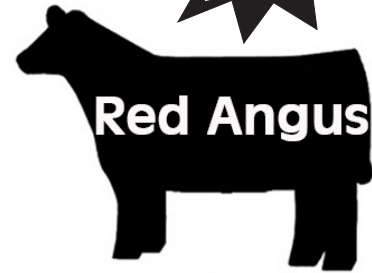

All cattle entering the Regional Red Angus Show must meet and follow the Rules and Regulations set forth in Section J of the Red Angus Association of American (RAAA) Rules and Regulations apply to all RAAA sponsored shows.

Ownership Requirements:

- All animals entered will: 1.) Have at least one owner on record as a Regular or Junior Member of RAAA by check-in. 2.) Be registered with RAAA and meet all requirements for Category 1A or 1B by the entry deadline. 3) Have Official Registered Status at the time of show's check-in.
- Exhibitors must have Official Ownership at the time of the late entry deadline, September 15, 2026.
- Substitutions will only be permitted for animals already entered and within the same sex, according to the hosting show's deadline, but no later than check-in.

General Regulations:

- Entries are accepted with the understanding that each exhibitor agrees to conform to the Rules and Regulations of the RAAA. Enforcement will be at the discretion of the RAAA authorized representatives and may include barring an animal or exhibitor.
- Exhibitors shall exhibit sportsmanship and professional behavior in and around the show ring. Abusive, discourteous, or threatening behavior towards judges, show officials, fellow exhibitors or RAAA authorized representatives will not be tolerated.
- DNA: Parent verification must be completed on the individual animal and verified to the greatest extent possible before shown. (Implementation date RAYE 2024 and all upcoming Regional and National shows. Ruling passed at January Board meeting)
 - All Grand and Reserve Champions and overall animals in all shows will have DNA collected to be parentage verified to the greatest extent.
 - Please submit your DNA as soon as possible to allow ample time for the lab to process for all Regional and National shows.
 - For questions regarding DNA, please contact the RAAA DNA department at dna@redangus.org.
- All animals must have legible tattoos which match the Animal ID and Herd Prefix as recorded in the RAAA database prior to processing:
 1. Animal ID and Herd Prefix verification may be via printed registration certificate or real time electronic representation of the RAAA database.
 2. If the Animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are not legible and cannot be read during processing, it will be allowed to participate in the show. A fee of \$100 will be charged to the exhibitor for a DNA parentage test of said animal.
 3. If the Animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are legible but are incorrect, the animal will not be allowed to show.

- Each animal will be exhibited in its natural conformation and structure and without any alterations or modifications, with the exception of acceptable fitting and grooming practices.
 - The use of paints, pumping and/or the addition of any hair or hair-like substances will not be allowed.
 - At the time of processing, all females 20 months of age or older on publicized date of show must have the one of the following:
 1. Certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian.
 2. Written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist of having produced fertile eggs.
 3. Female's own natural born calf at side, which need not be registered, but must be eligible for category 1A or 1 B registration in the RAAA.
 - All bulls 9 months of age or older on publicized date of show must be shown with a nose lead.
 - After processing, should the number of entries in any class exceed practicality, authorized representative of the RAAA have the authority to "split" classes according to age and at the date of birth that best encourages fair competition.
 - Any calf exhibited at the side of their dam in a cow/calf class may be exhibited in an individual class subject to all pertinent RAAA
- Declaration of Participation: Each exhibitor is subject to the "Declaration of Participation" in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the RAAA.

Group Class Numbers:

34. Produce of Dam - Two animals, either or both sexes, both shown in their respective classes. Animals shown in this class need not be owned by the exhibitor.**
35. Senior Get-of-sire - Four animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes. **
36. Junior Get-of-Sire - Three animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, 2024. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes. **
37. Premier Breeders Class - Will be computed from breeder's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)**
38. Premier Exhibitor Class - Will be computed from exhibitor's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5 (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)**
